Apple Cortland Dwf	9-12' h	Midseason	29-Sep	Red, sweet/tart, good eating-cooking. Stores well.
Apple Fireside Dwf	10' h	Midseason	17-Oct	Red, sweet, good eating-cooking. Resistant to cedar-apple rust.
Apple Haralred Dwf	9-10' h x 10' w	Late	1-Oct	Red, tart, good eating-cooking. Resists russetting.
Apple Honeycrisp Dwf	12' h	Midseason	21-Sep	Mottled red, sweet, good eating-dessert. Long picking range.
Apple Honeycrisp Semi-dwf	15-20'h	Midseason	21-Sep	Mottled red, sweet, good eating-dessert. Long picking range.
Apple Honeygold Dwf	12' h	Late	10-Oct	Yellow, sweet, good eating-dessert. Excellent storage life.
Apple McIntosh Dwf	9-12' h	Midseason	25-Sep	Red, sweet, good eating-cooking. Keeps well.
Apple Red Prairie Spy Dwf	9-12' h	Midseason	1-Oct	Red, tart, good eating-cooking. Holds fruit well.
Apple State Fair Dwf	9-12' h	Early	20-Aug	Red, tart, all purpose.
Apple Sweet Sixteen Dwf	10' h	Midseason	21-Sep	Red, sweet, good dessert, crisp, aromatic.
Apple Zestar Dwf	9-12' h	Early	27-Aug	Red striped, sweet, good eating. State Fair x Mn selection.
Apricot Moongold Dwf	12-15' h	Late April	Late July	Orange, sweet, good eating. Fruit stays on well.
Apricot Sungold Dwf	12-15' h	Late April	Early Aug	Gold, mild sweet, good eating-jam. Late variety.
Cherry Bali	6-12' h	Early May	August	Dark red, semi-sweet, good eating. Excellent hardiness.
Cherry North Star	6'-12' h	Early May	Late June	Red, tart, good for pie. Self-fertile.
Crabapple Chestnut	15-20' h x 15-20' w	Mid-May	7-Sep	Bronze-red, sweet, good eating. Nut-like flavor.
Crabapple Whitney	20-25' h x 25-30' w	Mid-May	25-Aug	Yellow with red stripes, sub-acid, good eating-pickling. Bears heavily.
Pear Parker Semi-Dwf	15' h	Early May	15-Aug	Yellow-bronze, sweet, good eating. Fruit is large and tender.
Pear Patten Semi-Dwf	15' h	Early May	15-Sep	Yellow, sweet good eating. Pick while green.
Plum American	15-20'h x 10-12' w	Early May	1-Aug	Reddish-yellow. Excellent for wildlife. Suitable pollinator.
Plum Mount Royal	10' h	Early May	20-Aug	Blue, sweet, good eating-dessert-jam. Self-fertile. Freestone.
Plum Pembina	10-15' h	Early May	25-Aug	Red, sweet, good dessert. Large size.Clingstone.
Plum Toka	15' h	Late April	15-Aug	Red, spicy sweet, good eating. Pollinator. Very fragrant. Clingstone.
Plum Waneta	10-15' h	Late April	27-Jul	Red, sweet, good eating. Good market plum. Clingstone.
